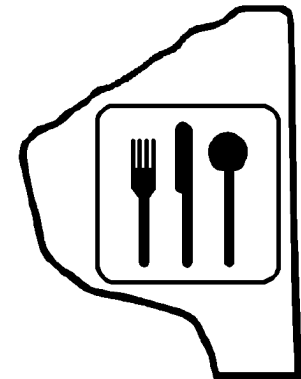
Women, Infants and Children Nutrition Program (WIC)
