FoodWise Program

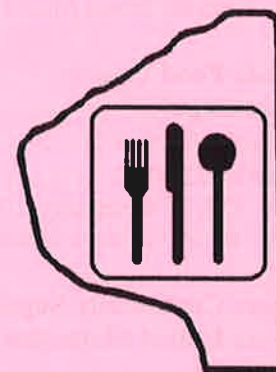
