Bus Services

The ADRC operates buses Monday through Friday to provide transportation to individuals age 60 and older or anyone who is disabled. Riders are picked up at their homes and transported to multiple locations. Destinations are decided by the passengers needs. Reservations are required.

Drivers will provide assistance with packages, if needed.

Trips Program

The Trips program is a door-to-door transportation service offered by the ADRC.

Transportation is provided by volunteer drivers using their own vehicles. To use this service, you must be able to get into and out of the vehicle on your own. Drivers can assist you, but cannot lift or provide any medical care. The Trips program's primary focus is for medical trips but other types of trips will be considered on a case by case basis.

Trips reservations should be made as soon as possible to allow the ADRC time to schedule a driver. Reservations must be made at least TWO BUSINESS DAYS prior to your appointment.

Fees are based on the passengers location and destination.
