You can support the Grant County Drug-Free effort by joining one or more committees. This is where all of the real work is done.

Compliance Check: oversees the alcohol and tobacco compliance checks to limit youth access.

Safe Driving: works on issues focusing on seatbelt usage, child safety checks, and drinking and driving.

Fresh Start: oversees and provides direction to the Fresh Start program, an alcohol-risk reduction program for individuals under 21.

Parent/Community Education: develops educational campaigns, sponsors family fun nights, and assists community parent groups with activities projects.

Policy/Ordinance: works towards policies or ordinances to promote safe and drug free communities.

Promotions & Sustainability: promotes the coalition and safe, drug-free activities, offers educational programs, and obtains funding.






