This service uses a team approach to provide care and comfort for terminally ill patients and their families in their home or other setting.

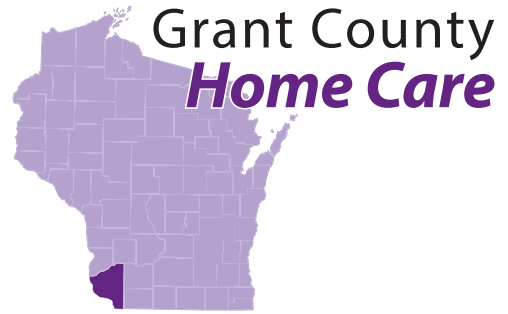
### **Public Health\***

## **What is Home Care?**

The healing process can require much time and energy on a patient's behalf. Being able to receive professional care in the privacy and comfort of a patient's home, can really make a difference in restoring the patient to their optimum level of health.

Our health care providers follow the direction of the patient's physician as they assist in the healing process.

### **Who is eligible?**

Any Grant County resident, regardless of age or ability to pay, who needs continuing medical

supervision and skilled nursing care is eligible. Referrals can come from anyone: physicians, hospitals, other agencies, families, friends, and even the patients themselves.

### **How do I pay for these services?**

The Home Care Program is reimbursed through Medicare, Medicaid, private insurance companies and HMOs. An adjusted fee scale is available for patients who do not have another payment source. We recognize the importance of these services and will work with the patient to make care available—*No patient will be denied care due to inability to pay.*

## **OUR HOME CARE SERVICES**

### **Skilled Nursing**

A registered nurse can provide skilled nursing in the patient's home, under a physician's orders. This includes injections, wound care, medication and dietary instructions, catheter care, ostomy care, blood draws, and I.V. therapy.

### **Home Health Aide**

A certified nursing assistant can provide care in areas such as bathing, dressing, nail care, and hair care.

### **Physical Therapy**

A physical therapist works with individuals in their home to regain or improve movement of the joints and muscles through exercise and other approved methods.

### **Speech Therapy**

A speech (language) pathologist can provide in-home instruction in the production of speech sounds, and assistance with swallowing difficulties.

### **Occupational Therapy**

An occupational therapist aids in improving daily living skills and fine motor coordination.
