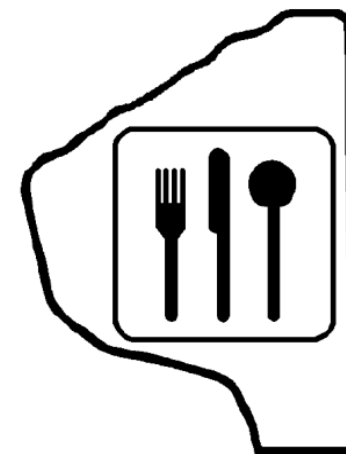
FoodWise Program
