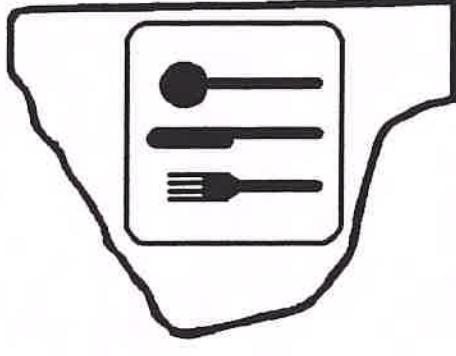
### **FoodWise Program**
