The purpose of this plan is to provide focus, guidance, and an overall sense of direction for the Grant County Board and its departments over the next five years.


The key word is 'guidance'.

# How did we get here?

- Our planning process started with an extensive review of the 2014 plan.
- We then proceeded to generate ideas using the categories from that plan.
- This resulted in a list of nearly 100 items.
- We then discussed, refined, and evaluated those ideas.
- The next step was to prioritize them and we did that from multiple perspectives.

...undertake/assist efforts that will dramatically improve broadband availability and quality to all residents and businesses

#### GOAL 1A...

# To best accomplish this ...

...establish a fiber backbone loop that provides access to high speed, redundant internet services

# Related thoughts:

- The NEED is there
- The SUPPORT is there
- The FUNDING is there

The County would not be directly providing internet services but can play a major role in providing access to those services. We have long known that access to technology is important but the recent pandemic underscored the critical need and dramatic shortcomings of our current situation.

Add to that the growing potential of funding from several sources and we have an unprecedented and likely fleeting opportunity to have significant impact.

# In the next five years Grant County will... ...reassess and improve infrastructure



#### GOAL 2A...

# To best accomplish this ...

...we will reassess our current road maintenance and replacement strategy to include

- Extending existing road life
- Ensure that rebuilding new roads meet today's demands
- Meeting current and future safety needs including consideration of shoulders or passing lanes for farm equipment, recreational traffic, etc.

### GOAL 2B...

...will build a new Highway Facility

### GOAL 2C...

- ...assess electrical grid and possible impact of vehicle charging stations
  - Identify and address ways to increase reliability while meeting expanding needs

#### Related thoughts:

Roads have long been a County priority but demands have increased, farm equipment is larger, recreational use is growing. When major reconstruction occurs we need to build to standards that meet future as well as current needs.

Electric powered vehicles are a new consideration as we assess future demands and distribution.

The local economy has seen increased benefit from tourism and visitor activity, especially as it relates to outdoor recreation. The growth in ATV/UTV use is likely to continue. The area has much potential for growth.

...it's easy to do a plan and then think we're done. Not by a long shot. To be more than a dust catcher on a shelf several things must happen:


- We would ask that all planning and new projects include the basic quesion, "How does this action align with or advance parts of our overall strategic plan?"


