

AFTER CLOSE CONTACT WITH SOMEONE WITH COVID-19

Students and Staff Not Vaccinated or Up To Date with COVID-19 Vaccinations

If you are unvaccinated or only received one dose of a Pfizer or Moderna vaccine

OR

If you are 12+ and completed the primary Pfizer or Moderna vaccines series longer than 5 months ago and haven't received a booster dose

OR

If you received the Johnson & Johnson vaccine longer than 2 months ago and haven't received a booster dose

OR

If you tested positive for COVID-19 more than 90 days ago with a viral test



- Stay home and away from other people in your household for at least 5 days after last close contact.
- Wear a well-fitting mask around others for an additional 5 days.
- Get tested at least 5 days after last close contact.
- If you develop symptoms or test positive, stay home. Follow instructions for isolation.



Get Tested Day 5*

If Negative, Return to School and Wear Mask for 5 Days

*If you develop symptoms or test positive for COVID-19, stay home and isolate for at least 5 full days. Wear a well-fitting mask when around others for an additional 5 days after ending isolation. If you have questions about when to return to school or if you test positive, contact your school.
