NATURE OF WORK

This position will assist mechanics in performing a variety of general maintenance and repairs of equipment and vehicles for the Highway Department as well as help maintain State/County roadways in Grant County.

- 1. One year of Experience in diesel mechanics, heavy duty truck mechanics or related fields
- 2. One year of experience in highway and road maintenance activities operating a variety of heavy equipment preferred

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- 1. Knowledge of standard practices and procedures in testing and repairing various types of diesel operated equipment/vehicles, automotive and other gasoline operated equipment
- 2. Knowledge of safety techniques used in heavy equipment repair
- 3. Skill in using hand and power tools
- 4. Knowledge of the use of tools and equipment applicable to maintenance and repair of motors, engine components and associated equipment
- 5. Knowledge of hydraulic and mechanical principles
- 6. Skill in recognizing, diagnosing and correcting mechanical trouble
- 7. Ability to work well in teams of co-workers
- 8. Ability to accept constructive criticism
- 9. Knowledge of hazards and safety precautions associated with equipment maintenance
- 10. Ability to read and understand written and oral instructions

- 11. Knowledge of techniques, methods, materials and equipment used in highway maintenance and improvement
- 12. Skill in operating highway maintenance and a variety of heavy equipment
- 13. Ability to move up to 60 lbs. repetitively
- 14. Ability to work in adverse weather/environmental conditions

Essential Functions

Under general direction

- 1. Safely perform maintenance and repair of gasoline and diesel automotive, truck, heavy truck, and construction equipment under a trained mechanics supervision
- 2. Examine equipment for mechanical, electrical and hydraulic defects and determine nature and extent of needed repairs
- 3. Repair equipment by adjusting, rebuilding, or replacing damaged mechanical or electrical parts
- 4. Requisition supplies, tools and materials
- 5. Replace worn plugs, points, rotors, pedals, mufflers, wires, etc.
- 6. Tune cars, trucks, mowers, and other engines
- 7. Maintain equipment service and maintenance records
- 8. Keep work areas neat and clean along with light building maintenance.
- 9. Plow snow and apply salt/sand as needed
- 10. Perform such other duties as may be assigned
- 11. Subject to emergency call ins
- 12. Evening, weekend and holiday work may be required

Supervision Received

General and specific assignments are received and work is performed according to methods and procedures with allowance for independence in judgement in accomplishing the assignments

Environmental Factors

Vibrations, noise and odor from heavy equipment; must be able to bend, lift and stoop to perform duties; personal protective equipment is required for many job tasks
