

Grant County Waste Storage Ordinance

- A permit from the County Conservation, Sanitation & Zoning Department (CSZD) is required prior to any new construction of a waste storage facility over 7000 cu. ft. Each permit application shall include a complete set of detailed construction plans and a Nutrient Management Plan.
- All applicants are required to pay a non-refundable permit fee at the time of application equal to \$200 to construct or alter and \$50 to close a facility
- Engineering assistance is available through the CSZD. The fee is based on 10% of the estimated cost not to exceed \$1,500. The fee will be refunded after completion and certification of the project.

Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP)

- EQIP is a federal cost share program administered by NRCS.
- EQIP can cost share a waste storage facility.
- Participants must complete a Comprehensive Nutrient Management Plan (CNMP). This is eligible for cost share.
- Participants will have to complete all agreed-to action items identified from the CNMP engineering walkover
- Participant will need to develop/update their Nutrient Management Plan to show they have adequate acres to spread manure produced by storage facility.
- Must build facility according to NRCS standards and specifications in accordance with the Grant County Waste Storage Ordinance.

Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection (DATCP)

- DATCP is a state cost share program administered by the County Land and Water Conservation Department.
- DATCP can cost share up to \$10,000, not to exceed 70%, for a waste storage facility.
- Participants will have to complete a Nutrient Management Plan and agree to update annually.
- Participants will sign a cost share contract. This contract indicates the participant is aware of the continuing compliance requirements of NR 151.
- Participant is encouraged to complete construction in the contract year, but may receive an extension to complete by December 31 of the second year.
- Must build according to NRCS standards and specifications in accordance with the Grant County Waste Storage Ordinance.
- Money may be combined with Federal or County cost share.
- Subject to approval by the Grant County CSZD Committee.

Grant County Cost Share

- County cost share is allocated directly from the Grant County CSZD annual budget.
- County can cost share up to \$3,500, not-to-exceed 75% for a waste storage facility.
- Money is allocated on a first-come, first-serve basis as approved by the Grant County CSZD Committee.
- Must build according to NRCS standards and specifications in accordance with the Grant County Waste Storage Ordinance.
- Money may be combined with Federal or State cost share.
