Public Involvement Meeting for County Q Reconstruction Project in Grant County planned for January 6, 2021

Grant County is in the process of developing plans for the reconstruction of 0.6 miles of County Q from just south of Homer Road to north of Church Road, including the replacement of the bridge on County Q over the Fennimore Creek.

County Q will be reconstructed on a new horizontal alignment that improves the horizontal curves within the project limits. The Homer Road intersection will also be reconstructed as part of the project. The proposed bridge will replace the existing three-span structure with a single span 54"W prestressed concrete girder bridge. The project corridor is classified as a Major Collector. Right of way acquisitions for the new roadway and temporary limited easements for grading are anticipated. Construction is currently scheduled to be in the summer of 2022.

For the safety of the public, the public meeting will be held virtually via **Zoom** (link provided below). Grant County will host a live broadcast of the virtual meeting at the Grant County Administrative Building, 2nd Floor Board Rm, 111 S Jefferson Street, Lancaster, WI 53813. If attending at the Grant County facility, COVID-19 safety precautions will be adhered to, including compliance with face mask protocols within the facility and social distancing requirements.

The meeting will take place on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>January 6</u>, <u>2021 from 1:00 PM until 2:00 PM</u>. A short presentation, which includes a basic overview of project concepts, will begin at 1:00 PM. Representatives from Grant County and project design staff will be available for the duration of the virtual meeting to answer questions and provide additional information regarding the project.
