The public hearing will be held for the purpose of receiving comment on Grant County's proposed plan for spending 85.21 allocation of \$129,300 and a required county match of \$25,860 to implement elderly and disabled transportation. It is proposed to use the available funds to facilitate, coordinate and operate 3 lift equipped vehicles on a regular basis throughout the county, to fund a volunteer driver escort program, and to reimburse volunteer driver mileage.
