

HIGHWAY COMMITTEE MEETING

June 9, 2011

The regular monthly meeting of the Grant County Highway Committee was held on Thursday, June 9, 2011 at the Highway Office in Lancaster, Wisconsin. Chairman Margaret Ruf called the meeting to order at 10:00 A.M..

Members present besides the Chairman were Donald Splinter, Mark Stead, Pat Schroeder, and Highway Commissioner David Lambert. Vern Lewison asked to be excused. Also present was County Board Supervisor Robert Keeney.

David Lambert said that the meeting notice had been sent to the radio, and newspaper, and posted in the Administration Building and Highway Department Office.

Donald Splinter, seconded by Pat Schroeder, moved to approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried.

Pat Schroeder, seconded by Donald Splinter, moved to approve the minutes of the May 12, 2011 and May 17, 2011 meetings as printed. Motion carried.

Mark Stead, seconded by Donald Splinter, moved to pay Vouchers #407 thru #530. Motion carried.

David began the Supervisors Reports, by explaining a problem in the Village of Mt. Hope. A property owner (David & Cindra Riemenapp) have constructed a concrete planter on the County right-of-way. The right-of-way is thirty three feet at this location and the item built is approximately seven feet out on the right-of-way. David sent a letter to the property owners asking that the concrete planter be removed in thirty days because of liability issues or the County will remove it.

For the first four months of 2011, Grant County was \$99,063.48 in the red for the maintenance work that we provided on the State Highway System. Total State Requisitions for the year thus far, were \$784,631.19 including all labor, equipment, materials, and administration.

Highway 81 in Beetown is under construction, milling and paving Hwy 61 from Dickeyville to Lancaster will start on June 13, 2011, and construction of the new bridge at Ellenboro will begin on June 13, 2011.

Paving will also be done this season on CTH "A", "U" & "V", & Highland "Q".

Travis Kramer presented a detailed plan of the costs involved in reconstructing CTH "HHH" through the Village of Kieler. Total cost of the project is estimated to be \$542,576.02 with the Grant County portion being \$288,178.50 and the Town of Jamestown portion being \$254,397.52.

Donald Splinter, seconded by Pat Schroeder, moved to approve the proposed plan as presented for the reconstruction of CTH "HHH" through the Village of Kieler. Motion carried.

Mark Stead, seconded by Donald Splinter, moved to adjourn at 11:08 A.M. to Thursday, July 14, 2011 at 9:00 A.M.. Motion carried.
