

HIGHWAY COMMITTEE MEETING  
March 17, 2015

A special meeting of the Grant County Highway Committee was held on Tuesday, March 17, 2015 in room 266 on the second floor of the Grant County Administration Building in Lancaster, Wisconsin. Chairman Donald Splinter called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M..

Members present besides the Chairman were John Patcle, Mark Stead, Grant Loy, Vern Lewison, and Highway Commissioner David Lambert. Also present was County Board Supervisor Dwight Nelson, County Board Chairman Robert Keeney, and Mike Bartels.

Notice of the meeting was sent to the newspaper and radio station and the agenda was posted at the Administration Building and Highway Office.

John Patcle, seconded by Grant Loy, moved to approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried.

Mark Stead, seconded by Vern Lewison, moved to accept the low bid of \$41,434.00 from Tennyson Implement for the purchase of metal culverts for 2015. Motion carried.

Grant Loy, seconded by Donald Splinter, moved to accept the bid from Burke Truck & Equipment in Madison for a dump body, pre-wet system, electrical system, 6" auger, 12' plow, and right side snow wing for two trucks. Motion carried.

John Patcle, seconded by Grant Loy, moved to purchase two Western Star single-axle Patrol Truck Chassis with Cummins Engines from Truck Country in Dubuque for \$101,648.00 each per managements recommendation. Motion carried.

John Patcle, seconded by Mark Stead, moved to accept the Hot Mix Asphalt bid from Iverson Construction for \$49.50 per ton for finish asphalt and \$49.00 per ton for binder asphalt. Motion carried.

Mark Stead, seconded by Vern Lewison, moved to accept the low bid of \$38,666.80 from The Kraemer Company for pulverizing on CTH "A" (CPL Lancaster - STH 129) and CTH "P" (CTH "A" - USH 18). Motion carried.

Mark Stead, seconded by Vern Lewison, moved to adjourn at 9:14 A.M.. Motion carried.
