The Grant County Law Enforcement Committee was called to order at 10:36 a.m. by Chairman Pat Schroeder. The following members and personnel were present:

Kelly Bird verified the agenda had been posted at the County Clerk's office and Courthouse. Kelly posted the agenda in the Sheriff's Department lobby. The bills for the Sheriff's Office and Coroner were approved in motions by Mike and seconded by Bob S. All above motions carried.

Under Sheriff's Briefing, Sheriff Dreckman passed the activity report out to the members for discussion.

There was a mistake in the tow truck calling rotation. The tow truck company was called and advised of the mistake. This is the first incident since the rotation has been in effect.

A conditional offer has been made to an individual from Fennimore to fill the open Jailer position.

Overtime is up due to the shortage in the jail. Grant money is received for some overtime. The Village of Dickeyville is being charged at the overtime rate and will be reimbursing the Sheriff's Office for extra hours worked.

The Annual Report was handed out and discussed with the committee. It was noted that underage drinking citations are down.

There is no training to discuss at this time.

There are no grants to discuss at this time.

There are no maintenance issues to discuss at this time.

There is no new business to discuss at this time.

Under Old Business, Sheriff Dreckman signed the contract with Zuercher Software. The contract was given to Corporation Counsel for review before signing. Meetings will be set up to schedule implementation of the software.
