Pat Schroeder thanked everyone for the opportunity to be on the Law Enforcement Committee. Pat also discussed some incidents he has had involving the Humane Society.

The NACO Conference will be held in Minneapolis this summer. It was motioned by Pat and seconded by Mike to recommend that Gary Ranum attend the training if there was no one else available. Motion carried. Gary is able to stay with a family member while attending the conference.

There are no grants to discuss at this time.

There are no maintenance issues to discuss at this time.

Under New Business, it was motioned by Pat and seconded by Lester to look at other facilities to take stray dogs to that are picked up by Law Enforcement. Motion carried. Pat has offered to meet with them personally and then have them contact the Sheriff's Office.
