LAND INFORMATION COUNCIL July 28, 2021

The Land Information Council met on Wednesday, July 28, 2021, at 1:00 p.m. at the Administration Building, 111 S. Jefferson Street, Lancaster, WI, Room 264, Second Floor.

The meeting was called to order at 1:01 p.m. Tonya White verified that the meeting was in compliance with the open meeting law, posted at the Administration Building, Courthouse and on the county website.

Agenda: Chris Johll, second by Tammy Hampton made a motion to approve the agenda. Motion carried by voice vote.

Minutes: Tammy Hampton, second by Andrea Noethe made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 30, 2021 meeting. Motion carried by voice vote.

Introduction of GIS Specialist Nathan Tranel: Nathan gave an introduction and has met all the members present in the room.

Remonumentation update: Jay was unable to attend the meeting but sent an update. The remonumentation process has been slow. He does have 30 tie sheets that need to be dropped off.

Discussion on mapping data updates including GeoLynx: Chris and Nathan will need to get together in the near future to go over what updates need to be done. Nathan is slowly starting to update what is inhouse for public viewing.

Discussion and possible action on GCS/Land Nav updates: Andrea has been looking at Fidlar. Fidlar will work with GCS and would replace document indexing. Land Nav has not gotten back to Carrie with information on Conservation and Deeds.

Discussion and possible action on the Address Point Layer: Chris is still finding errors and correcting address points that are out of sequence.

Discussion and possible action to update ArcGIS system: Shane and Nathan discussed the update this morning. The process will take about a year to complete. Nathan and Dana will be collaborating on the project together.

2022-2024 County Land Information Plan: All of the projects that have been discussed need to be in the plan.

Data Sharing Protocols: Southwestern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission would like to sign an MOU with Grant County so we can share information. The Council also needs to look at the ordinance that set fees. It may need to be updated.

Other Land Information Discussion: Elections will be held at the next meeting. Tammy gave an update that the Tax Listers are compiling information to discuss about assessor practices with the DOR representative that will be at the annual meeting.
