Jon informed the Committee that Daimler Truck has announced a MY2023 price surcharge across all Makes/Models due to supplier cost increases, labor and delivery cost increases. The Western Star 4700 increase is \$4500.00 per truck which will be passed on to Grant County. Discussion followed as to if the County should cancel the order or pay the cost increase.

Motion by Lester Jantzen, seconded by John Patcle, to pay the surcharge of \$4500.00 per truck. Motion carried by majority vote with Mark Stead voting no.

Motion by Mark Stead, seconded by Dwight Nelson, to enter into closed session per State Statute 19.85 (1)(c) considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility as it relates to interviewing candidates to fill the vacant - Fennimore County Patrolman Position.
