State crews have spent many hours plowing snow the past few weeks and hauling salt. They are fixing guardrail from accidents, and busy moving materials out of the old sign shop.

County crews have spent many hours plowing snow the past few weeks and hauling winter abrasives. They are hauling sealcoat chips in preparation for the summer sealcoating season.

The shop has been very busy keeping the mainline trucks and spares on the road during the storms. Mike is going to send out specs on a new Excavator with attachments.

Pat Schroeder, seconded by Roger Guthrie made a motion to sign the design contract with Jewell Associates for the CTH "HH" project. Motion carried without a negative vote.

The retention of the 2022 Federal Aid Secondary \$302,651 budgeted amount was tabled and will be brought back to the Committee at the May meeting.
