HIGHWAY COMMITTEE MEETING June 15, 2023

The April Requisition was sent to the State for \$187,307.93, we are over our estimated monthly budgeted amount by \$70,219.56.

Dan McLimans informed the Committee the State crews have been ditching on Hwy 18. They have also been working on DMAs, working bridge sealing bridges, crack sealing, and concrete repair.

Steve Morgan reported the county crews have been working on disking the Wyalusing beach, putting in guardrail and curb and gutter on CTH O.

Mike informed the committee a tractor that needs a new transmission at a \$40,000 cost. Excavator should be in first part of July.

Travis informed the Committee the "H" frontage road is not going to happen, no contractors available, and the budget cannot support it. Travis also discussed future access on CTH "HH."

Chris Blume with SEH joined the committee to discuss what his company can do as far as bridge designing.
