EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE October 24, 2023

Porter Wagner, seconded by Carol Beals, moved to recommend for approval to the County Board the 2024 wage increases and with the recommendations for implementation and the ability to sustain, contingent upon funding, as follows:

- 1. Incorporate Orchard Manor wage schedule into the General wage schedule
- 2. Across the board increase as follows with a fiscal impact of \$1.6M over 2023.

Grade C- G 14% Grade H – I 8% Grade J – O 6%

3. Immediate moratorium on individual position pay adjustment requests. (To be reviewed during the 2025 budget process), i.e.,

Critical pay

Shift differentials

Bonus payouts

Reclassification requests

- 4. Moratorium on creation of new positions. (To be reviewed during 2025 budget process.)
- 5. Review and consider not refilling non-critical vacant positions
- 6. Departments adjust processes to allow for current staffing or less staffing through attrition
- 7. Overtime must be managed to reduce costs
- 8. Strict employee accountability maximize productivity
- 9. Department Head accountability budget and policy
