Concrete blocks have been set in place on CTH O. The County patrol men are putting up and fixing snow fence, and the last of the County Salt has been delivered.

The new bushhog is in, and both Chassis' are completed and have been sent to Burke for installation of the snow equipment.

Donnie Splinter, seconded by Gary Northouse made a motion to assign the \$226,454.72 undesignated revenues from 2021 to the Federal Aid Secondary account. Motion carried without a negative vote.
