Grant Program: First round of applicants were received and approved in January 2010. The second round of applications will be due by July 1, 2010. Only completed grant applications will be considered. This included required reports from previous grant recipients. The next review and approval of applications will be held on July 8, 2010 at 1 p.m.

Kyle Vesperman gave a review of the grant application project and will assist Bryan Wood in the future of this project, as needed.
